Voltas Beko donates ventilators to hospitals in Sanand, Gujarat

~ Helps the community close to its manufacturing facility fight the Covid 19 pandemic~

Mumbai, 18th September 2020: Voltbek Home Appliances Private Limited (Voltbek) - a JV between India's No. 1 AC Brand, Voltas and Europe's leading consumer durables player, Arçelik, has announced its plans to donate ventilators to help India fight against the ongoing pandemic. In sync with Arçelik's global mission to help countries battle the pandemic, India has received ventilators to help the communities that they operate in. Other countries to receive this support are Ukraine, Romania, Russia, the Philippines, Indonesia, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nigeria, Kenya and South Africa.

Impacting lives positively is deeply rooted in the Voltas Beko philosophy. Over the decades, Voltas has introduced several initiatives to uplift the lives of its employees and the communities it thrives in. As India's healthcare infrastructure struggles to keep up with the rising Covid-19 cases, this is one such measure to help the community surrounding Voltas Beko's first factory in Sanand, Gujarat which commenced operation in January 2020.

In April, Arçelik revealed it had joined forces with BioSys, defence firm Aselsan and aviation company Baykar Technologies to produce mechanical ventilators, in a collective effort led by the Turkish Ministry of Industry and Commerce and the Ministry of Health. A team of 120 engineers used rapid prototyping facilities at Arçelik Garage, an open innovation centre in Istanbul, to design and test the initial prototype in just 2 weeks. By June, 5,000 devices had been manufactured at its Çerkezköy electronics on a not-for-profit basis to meet domestic and international demand.

With India's coronavirus cases crossing the 5 million-mark, it is crucial for the private sector to step up and help the government, the economy and the community. Voltas is humbled by this opportunity to serve the community in Sanand and its neighborhood.

The Tata Group has committed INR 1500 crore towards the PM Care Fund, built to support the Covid-19 relief. Tata employees have, in addition, contributed tens of crores towards various response projects. Additionally, the Tata Son's Foundation has donated a total of Rs.10 crores, 100 ventilators and 20 ambulances to Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC).
